Pharmacy Management Program for Workers' Compensation

HEWTT, COLEMAN & ASSOCIATES, INC., our Workers' Compensation Administrator, has implemented a pharmacy program that will make it easier for you to fill a prescription should you have a work related injury that is treated by a designated physician.

Please note: this program is for WORKERS' COMPENSATION prescriptions ONLY.

There are several things that you must do to make this program work:

You must have your pharmacy card, your prescription and utilize a network pharmacy

1. You must present the "Temporary Card" issued by our company representative OR the registered pharmacy card that you will receive via mail.
2. You must utilize a participating pharmacy. Review the list in the back of your booklet. If you do not have the list, or you do not know the location of a participating pharmacy, you may call the Customer Service Center at 1-800-945-5951. A representative will be happy to assist you in locating a network pharmacy near you.
3. You must have your prescription with you to present to the pharmacist.
4. The pharmacist will fill your prescription for you. You will not have to pay anything out of pocket for your work related prescription.

If your physician requires that you receive medications over an extended period of time, as a maintenance medication, it may be possible to have the medications mailed directly to your home. Prescriptions for mail order are generally filled within 48 hours. There is no out-of-pocket expense for your work-related prescriptions. To being MAIL ORDER delivery of your medications, please contact your adjuster at Hewitt Coleman.
